

### Mind the Gap! Starting your Career in Germany


- preparing intern. students for the German job market and/or a business start-up
- students choose their focus: job market, start-up or both
- 25 students per cohort; from all faculties; bachelor, master & Ph.D.
- 2 semesters (1 phase = 1 semester)
- individual coaching, workshops, events, company visits

### Mind the Gap! – professional 2015-2017

- preparing int. students in their final phase of their studies for the German job market
- no start-up / entrepreneurship option
- average age: 26
- 50 participants in total (chosen from 110 applicants in total)







## Mind the Gap! – professional 2015-2017

- 1<sup>st</sup> cohort
  - 25 students; from 2 faculties; bachelor, master & Ph.D.
  - 3 semesters: April 2016 July 2017
- 2<sup>nd</sup> cohort:
  - 25 students; from 5 faculties
  - bachelor & master
  - 3 semesters: Oct. 2016 Dec. 2017






# Mind the Gap! Starting your Career in Germany 2018-2020

- with minor adjustments based on qualitative evaluation research (see below)
- adds the start-up option
- application phase has begun in Feb. 2018
- cohort will start in April 2018
