



Notional workload needed to achieve the learning outcomes (in ECTS, wherever possible) Level (and cycle, if applicable) of the learning experience leading to the micro-credential (EQF, QF EHEA), if applicable

Type of assessment

Form of participation in the learning activity

Type of quality assurance used to underpin the microcredential



Micro-credentials

U!REKA SHIFT plans to develop at least three micro-credentials on sustainability and digital transitions

INVEST plans to develop a micro-credential and lifelong learning platform

UNITA developed a framework of microcredentials





European Universities Initiative projects – Examples (2/3)

Digital transition

ENHANCE offers **ECTS** microcredentials with a thorough quality assurance and formal assessment of learning outcomes (ENHANCE Label in data literacy). ENHANCE life-long learning courses leading to microcredentials in digital transformation and Certificate in Higher Education Teaching designed for academic staff.
