# Process and progress - what did we do?

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## While in Norway

- Selecting the project focus
  - Brainstorming ideas (28!)
  - Defining scope & feasibility
  - Anticipating challenges
  - Consulting other teams
- Planning next steps
  - Dividing tasks
  - Creating shared documents



## Since leaving Norway

- Gathering library resources
  - Consulting experts
  - Searching existing resource banks
  - Identifying key topics/themes
- Building the library
  - Writing descriptive content
  - Generating the website
  - Assigning resources to themes

- How to host the library (online)?
- How big or small should the library be?
- How to maintain the website over time?
- How to ensure equality of access to resources?
