

Finalise the call

Launch the call: applications are open!

Applications close: Evaluation Phase 1 begin

Announcement of awarded Phase 1 ends, Phase 2 begins projects

Ensure that it is still relevant & clear. Consider addressing applicants' feedback from previous editions.


Keep it open for one month. Ensure smooth use of the application platform.

Platform assigns applications to evaluators. Average 1.5 months for this phase.

Once all applications have been assessed in Phase 1, set up a threshold and share the preselected applications (those above threshold) with the final evaluation panel. Consider the use of Miro or similar platforms for consensus building.




